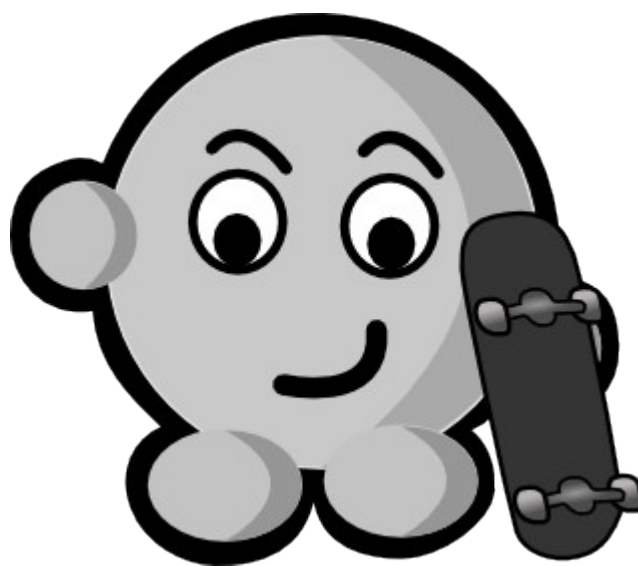


Skateboard Deck Design

Introduction to using different modes and media



Brief:

Design the imagery for a skateboard deck that uses a range of different media and modes.

Your deck design needs to include:

- A brand name (can be made up or real)
- imagery that reflects skateboard culture
- at least two of the following geometric solids:
 - cube
 - pyramid
 - cylinder
 - tube

- one of the following drawing styles must be used to render the geometric shapes
 - isometric
 - oblique
 - perspective

- use at least two of the following media
 - ink
 - pastels
 - pencils (coloured and graphite)
 - coloured cardboard
 - transparencies

The Design Process:

1. **Research** existing skateboard deck to see what sort of design work has been done before. Look in skate magazines, skate shops around town, the internet etc.

Write beside each design what you like and don't like about them

2. **Sketch ideas** for your own deck. Try lots of ideas. You can use the provided deck template or come up with your own.
3. **Choose an idea** that you really like and draw it on a fresh sheet of paper.
4. **Render your idea** using the range of media provided above. Draw, trace and stencil shapes that you can use on your deck. Explore different colours, sizes, shapes, textures and layouts.
5. Complete an **evaluation** sheet
6. **Hand in your finished skateboard deck** with all the sketches, ideas and evaluation
